The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about August ____, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone and/or in complicity with another person(s), knowingly and unlawfully took or exercised control over a sum of money in the form of cash in an amount \$10,000 or more but less than \$1,000,000, same being the movable property of [REDACTED] and/or another person, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, said property having a value of \$10,000 or more but less than \$1,000,000, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about August ____, 2023, through on or about November ____, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone and/or in complicity with another person(s), received, retained, or disposed of a sum of money in the form of cash in an amount \$10,000 or more, same being the movable property of [REDACTED] and/or another person, and the defendant knew that the property had been stolen or had reason to believe that it had been stolen, and the defendant did not receive, retain, or dispose of the property with the intent to return it to the owner, said property having a value of \$10,000 or more, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about August ____, 2023, through on or about November ____, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense(s) of Theft by Unlawful Taking/Disposition - \$10,000 or more but less than \$1,000,000, in violation of KRS 514.030; and Receiving Stolen Property - \$10,000 or More, in violation of KRS 514.110, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date(s) of August ____, 2023, through on or about November ____, 2023, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date(s) of August ____, 2023, through on or about November ____, 2023, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date(s) of August ____, 2023, through on or about November ____, 2023, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

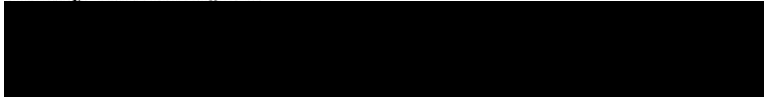

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle with one or more headlights not in compliance with the requirements and limitations as required by KRS Chapter 189, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named

defendant intentionally prevented or attempted to prevent Adair County Deputy Sheriff Hunter Tweedy and/or Adair County Deputy Sheriff Josh Durbin, who were recognized to be acting under color of official authority, from effecting an arrest of the defendant by using or threatening to use physical force or violence against Adair County Deputy Sheriff Hunter Tweedy and/or Adair County Deputy Sheriff Josh Durbin, or by using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to Adair County Deputy Sheriff Hunter Tweedy and/or Adair County Deputy Sheriff Josh Durbin, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed suboxone, a Schedule III narcotic, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Trafficking in a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully trafficked in two (2) grams or more of methamphetamine, this being a second or subsequent such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of

substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his second such offense within a ten (10) year period, and the Defendant refused to submit to any test or tests of his blood, breath, or urine requested by an officer having reasonable grounds to believe the Defendant was operating or in physical control of a motor vehicle in violation of Subsection (1) of KRS 189A.010, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he did not have his operator's license in his possession, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the Third Degree upon Adair County Deputy Sheriff Hunter Tweedy, who is a state, county, city, or federal peace officer, by intentionally causing or attempting to cause physical injury to Adair County Deputy Sheriff Hunter Tweedy, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 9:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the Third Degree upon Adair County Deputy Sheriff Josh Durbin, who is a state, county, city, or federal peace officer, by intentionally causing or attempting to cause physical injury to Adair County Deputy Sheriff Josh Durbin, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 10:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant having been prescribed, sold, or dispensed a controlled substance by a practitioner or other person authorized pursuant to KRS Chapter 218A, unlawfully possessed the controlled substance in a container other than that in which it was delivered to him by the person selling or dispensing same, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 11:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 12, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense(s) of Trafficking in a Controlled Substance in the First Degree, Second or Subsequent Offense [two (2) grams or more of methamphetamine], in violation of KRS 218A.1412, and Assault in the Third Degree – Police Officer [two (2) counts], in violation of KRS 508.025, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of February 12, 2026, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of February 12, 2026, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of February 12, 2026, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

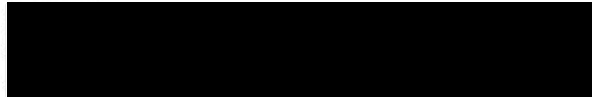

Roberts, Jr., to commit the offense of Sexual Abuse in the First Degree; or she aided, counseled, or attempted to aid William R. Roberts, Jr., in planning or committing the offense of Sexual Abuse in the First Degree; or, having a legal duty to prevent the commission of the offense of Sexual Abuse in the First Degree, she failed to make a proper effort to do so, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 2 AND 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 1, 2015, through on or about September 8, 2017, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, with the intention of promoting or facilitating the commission of the offense of Sodomy in the First Degree, on at least two (2) separate occasions, she solicited, commanded, or engaged in a conspiracy with William R. Roberts, Jr., to commit the offense of Sodomy in the First Degree; or she aided, counseled, or attempted to aid William R. Roberts, Jr., in planning or committing the offense of Sodomy in the First Degree; or, having a legal duty to prevent the commission of the offense of Sodomy in the First Degree, she failed to make a proper effort to do so, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 4 AND 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 1, 2015, through on or about September 8, 2017, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, with the intention of promoting or facilitating the commission of the offense of Sodomy in the Second Degree, on at least two (2) separate occasions, she solicited, commanded, or engaged in a conspiracy with William R. Roberts, Jr., to commit the offense of Sodomy in the Second Degree; or she aided, counseled, or attempted to aid William R. Roberts, Jr., in planning or committing the offense of Sodomy in the Second Degree; or, having a legal duty to prevent the commission of the offense of Sodomy in the Second Degree, she failed to make a proper effort to do so, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 1, 2015, through on or about September 8, 2017, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, with the intention of promoting or facilitating the commission of the offense of Incest, she solicited, commanded, or engaged in a conspiracy with William R. Roberts, Jr., to commit the offense of Incest; or she aided, counseled, or attempted to aid William R. Roberts, Jr., in planning or committing the offense of Incest; or, having a legal duty to prevent the commission of the offense of Incest, she failed to make a proper effort to do so, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 1, 2015, through on or about September 8, 2017, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, with the intention of promoting or facilitating the commission of the offense of Unlawful Transaction with Minor in the First Degree / Illegal Sex Act – Victim Less than Sixteen (16) Years Old, she solicited, commanded, or engaged in a conspiracy with William R. Roberts, Jr., to commit the offense of Unlawful Transaction with Minor in the First Degree / Illegal Sex Act – Victim Less than Sixteen (16) Years Old; or she aided, counseled, or attempted to aid William R. Roberts, Jr., in planning or committing the offense of Unlawful Transaction with Minor in the First Degree / Illegal Sex Act – Victim Less than Sixteen (16) Years Old; or, having a legal duty to prevent the commission of the offense of Unlawful Transaction with Minor in the First Degree / Illegal Sex Act – Victim Less than Sixteen (16) Years Old, she failed to make a proper effort to do so, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
