COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about February 16, 2018 in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed a controlled substance that is classified as a Schedule I or II, (Methamphetamine) which is a narcotic drug, or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 16, 2018 in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed drug paraphernalia or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 16, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to maintain required insurance or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 16, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant who has not applied for an operator's license or whose operator's license has been denied, canceled, suspended or revoked, or whose privilege to operate a motor vehicle has been withdrawn, shall operate any motor vehicle upon the highways while license is denied, canceled, suspended, or revoked or his privilege to operate a motor vehicle is withdrawn, or the license has not been applied for or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 16, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to wear seat belt while operating a motor vehicle upon the roadway or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 16, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant improperly displayed registration plates or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 16, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to have the receipt issued by the cabinet through the county clerk constantly in his possession or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about February 16, 2018 in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to have registration plate conspicuously upon the rear of the motor vehicle or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 9:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 16, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant shall not operate a motor vehicle on a public highway, road, or street with any sign, sun screening material, product, or covering attached to, or located in or upon the windshield, except the following: a certificate or other paper required to be displayed by law; sun screening material along a strip at the top of the windshield, if the material is transparent and does not encroach upon the driver's direct forward viewing area as defined in Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards No 205 as the AS/1 portion of the windshield or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
