The Grand Jury charges that on or about May 13, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life wantonly engage in conduct which creates substantial danger of death to another person or engages in conduct which creates substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person or aided abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about May 13, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant while operating a motor vehicle with intent to elude or flee, the person knowingly or wantonly disobeys a direction to stop his or her motor vehicle, given by a person recognized to be a police officer, and a least one (1) of the following conditions exists: the person is fleeing immediately after committing an act of domestic violence as defined in KRS 403.720; or the person is driving under the influence of alcohol or any other substance or combination of substances in violation of KRS 189A.010; or the person is driving while his or her driver's license is suspended for violating KRS 189A.010; or by fleeing or eluding, the person is the cause, or creates substantial risk, of serious physical injury or death to any person or property or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 9:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about May 13, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a peace officer, recognized to be acting under color of his official authority, from effecting an arrest of the actor or another by: using or threatening to use physical force or violence against the peace officer or another; or using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to the peace officer or another or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 10:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about May 13, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant shall not operate or be in physical control of a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 11:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 13, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to wear seat belt while operating a motor vehicle upon the roadway or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 12:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 13, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant had in his or her possession an open alcoholic beverage container in the passenger area of a motor vehicle located on a public highway or on the right a way of a public highway or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 13:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 13, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant disregarded stop sign or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 14:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 13, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a vehicle upon a highway at a greater speed than is reasonable and prudent, having no regard for the traffic and for the condition and use of the highway or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



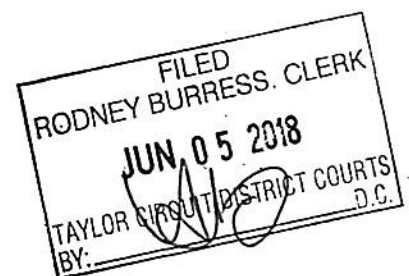


